Gladys West	Created the Bombe, which helped to crack the German Enigma Code.
André Truong Trong Thi	Helped invent the Global Positioning System (GPS) based on their mathematical work on satellites.
Steve Jobs and Steve Wozniak	Wrote the first ever computer code.
Sir Tim Berners-Lee	Co-founders of Microsoft, who created Windows, Microsoft Office and XBOX.
Bill Gates and Paul Allen	Co-founders of Apple, who created Mac computers, iPads and iPhones.
Alan Turing	Helped create the 'Deep Blue' computer that was used to defeat world chess champion Garry Kaparov at a game of chess.
Mark E. Dean	Created the world's first commercial microcomputer and is considered the 'father of the personal computer'.
Feng-Hsiung Hsu	Worked at NASA as a mathematician. Recalculated equations that had been solved by a mechanical computer to prove they were correct.
Akira Nakashima	Helped develop the original IBM PC, along with designing and testing the PC Colour Graphic Adapter - the same type of colour monitor that we use today.
Larry Page and Sergey Brin	Laid the foundation for the design of digital circuits found in modern computers and technology.
Katherine Johnson	Inventors of Google.
Ada Lovelace	Invented the World Wide Web (WWW).
Dabbala Rajagopal 'Raj' Reddy	Pioneer of Artificial Intelligence (A.I)
