| Algorithm | A clear set of instructions to carry out a task. |
| :--- | :--- |
| Bug | An error or mistake in computer code. |
| Computer | Electronic machine that accepts and processes information <br> to produce an output, and then stores the results. |
| Debug | To fix the error in code. |
| Decompose | To break something down into smaller chunks. |
| Device | Equipment created for a certain purpose or job. |
| Input | A way of telling the computer what you want it to do. |
| Instructions | A list of commands and directions on how to do something. |
| Output | Information or data that is sent by the computer to an <br> output device such as a printer or speakers. |
| Solution | The method to solve a problem. |
