Added to Art and design in 2021

- ★ Vocabulary progression document showing the progression of vocabulary in the Kapow Primary Art and design scheme of work year by year.

Coming to Art and design 2022



The scheme will:

- offer greater clarity over core art and design knowledge
- offer sequential lessons organised into four core strands: Drawing, Painting and mixed media, Sculpture and 3D, Craft and design
- provide reassurance that complex skills are built upon over time to enable control and proficiency
- provide children with a broad and balanced 'whole story' of art, with each unit exploring the work of a key artist in greater depth
- provide a range of unit outcomes to further develop pupil's creativity and cross-curricular opportunities
- include greater emphasis on the use of sketchbooks for pupils to revisit ideas and apply their knowledge and skills when responding to stimuli
- include some alternative unit and lesson options to provide opportunities for teachers to link to the wider-curriculum or festivals and celebrations, whilst maintaining core art and design objectives.
