




What's coming to Music in 2022!

Added to Music in 2021

- ★ KS2 Whole-class instrumental scheme: a progressive collection of 30 lessons in line with the DfE's 2020 Model Music Curriculum guidance.
- ★ <u>Staff notation teacher skills videos</u> to accompany the KS2 Whole-class instrumental scheme.
- \star <u>Knowledge organisers</u> for every unit.
- ★ Long term plans which include: how the Music scheme fulfils the National curriculum requirements for KS1 and KS2; an overview of the units and guidance on the order of teaching.
