

Ofsted inspection toolkit

Comparison of a Section 5 and Section 8 inspection

Schools judged to be outstanding in their previous section 5 inspection used to be exempt from routine inspections. This is not now the case and all formerly exempt schools must receive an initial inspection under section 5 (if previously inspected before September 2015) or section 8 (if previously inspected after September 2015) before 1 August 2026.

Section 5	Section 8
 Full inspection. 2 days. Focuses on all areas: Quality of Education, Behaviour and attitudes, Personal development, Leadership and management. 	 Inspection for schools previously judged to be 'Good' or 'Outstanding'. Confirms that the school remains good or outstanding and that safeguarding is effective. 1 to 2 days.
Graded judgements for each area.	 Fewer inspectors on site. No graded judgements for each area. Focus primarily on Quality of Education.
