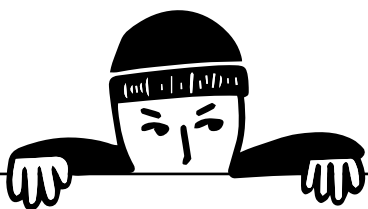


Online Safety Answers

Only allow trusted friends and family to see your information and photos online. Never share your information or photos with strangers.

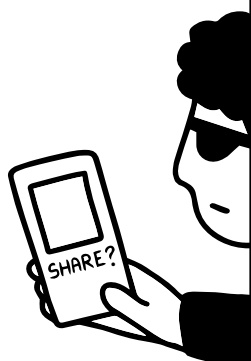


What information tells someone where you live or go to school?
