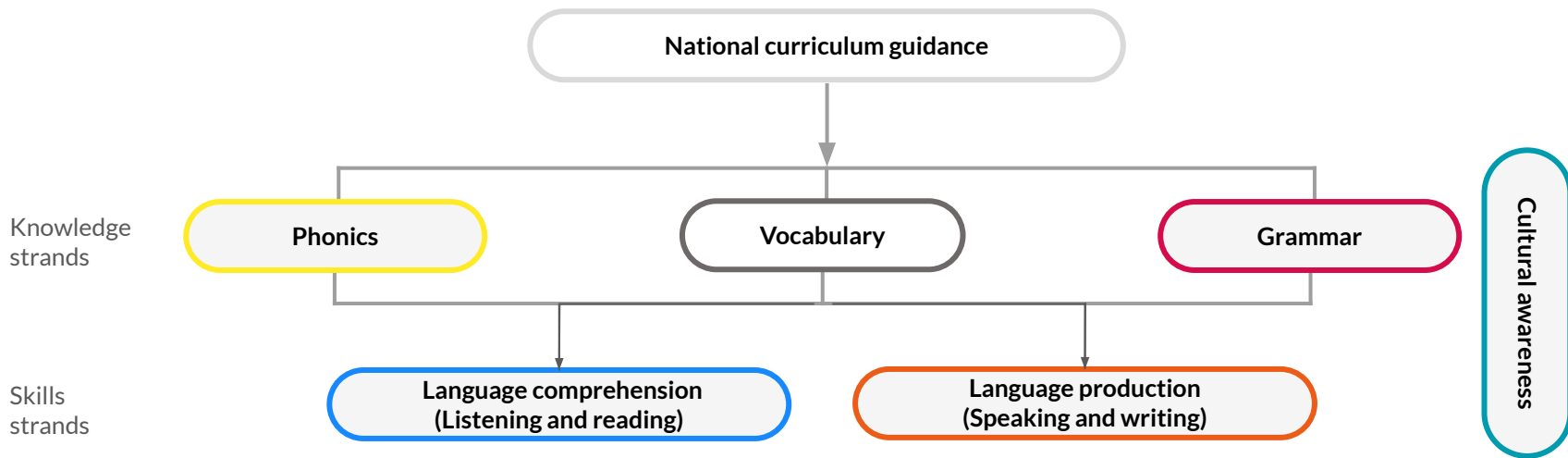
# Scheme design

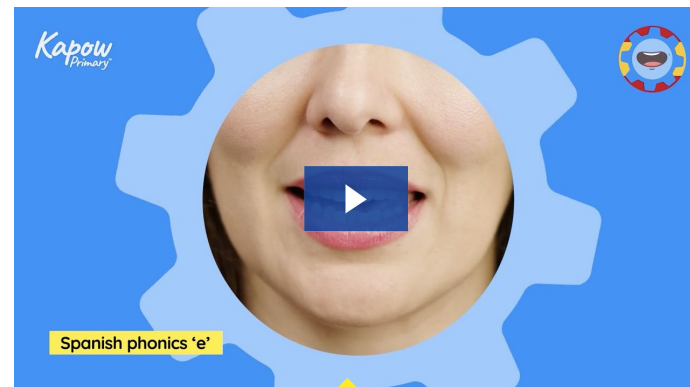

The scheme develops language detective skills, essential for developing independent, engaged language learners. These skills include:

- Recognising learned vocabulary
- Spotting cognates
- Using context to predict word meanings
- Analysing word order

Our scheme progressively develops these skills so that, by Year 6, pupils can confidently decipher unfamiliar language and improve their understanding of Spanish language and grammar.

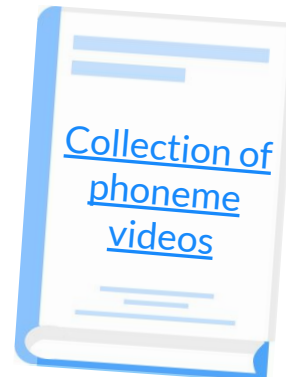
