How to use this audit

This subject knowledge audit has been designed to help subject leaders identify gaps in teacher subject knowledge so that they can support teachers effectively.

Encourage teachers to review statements for each teaching phase and assess their confidence and support needs. The statements align with the Kapow Primary Spanish curriculum, highlighted in the progression of skills, knowledge and vocabulary document.

If teachers are lacking in confidence, there are a few things you can do to support them:

- Ensure they have some time to look at the suggested Kapow Primary teacher videos independently.
- Pair them with a teacher who is confident in that area to support them.
- Set up further training opportunities in school during staff meetings or INSET (if there is a common area of need).

Our Spanish phoneme videos feature <u>Mouth Mechanics</u> to help pupils master correct pronunciation and articulation. Teachers can also use them for personal skill practice and as a valuable CPD resource. These can be located in the 'Watch' or 'Pupil phoneme videos' tabs within a lesson.

Please be aware that the teacher videos mentioned in this document were originally created for individual lessons. However, they can still be valuable for ongoing CPD and enhancing teachers' understanding of the curriculum sequence.
