anointed	Chosen by a higher power to fulfill a specific role or responsibility.
authority	The power or right to give orders, make decisions and enforce obedience.
bloodline	The genetic or biological relationship between family members.

succession	When one person follows another.
Sunnah	The way of life and habits of Prophet Muhammad that Muslims try to follow.
religious law	Rules that come from the interpretation of religious teachings.
revelation	When something special is shown or told to people, often something that comes from God.
ummah	The community of Muslims all over the world.

Lehna was chosen as Guru Nanak's successor for his humility and service, becoming Guru Angad, embodying Sikh values of selflessness and devotion.
