French

A summary of key French learning for Year 3 to Year 6.

Year 3			
Autumn 1	French greetings with puppets	Autumn 2	French adjectives of colour, size and shape
	Learning French greetings and introductions through puppets and role play. Pupils practise using a range of greetings and learn how to choose the appropriate greeting according to the time of day.		Describing shapes using French adjectives for colour and size. Pupils learn how adjectives are positioned in relation to nouns, identify cognates between English and French and apply their knowledge when describing objects.
Spring 1	French playground games – numbers and age	Spring 2	In a French classroom
	Learning to count from 1 to 12 in French and use numbers in simple conversations. Pupils ask and answer questions about age and compare similarities and differences between French and English sentence structures.		Responding to common classroom instructions and learning vocabulary for familiar classroom items. Pupils take part in games to develop their understanding and learn that French nouns are categorised as either masculine or feminine.
Summer 1	French transport	Summer 2	A circle of life in French
	Developing French vocabulary related to transport by using detective skills to identify cognates and infer meaning. Pupils learn how to use forms of the verb aller (to go) and apply them to build simple sentences.		Building French vocabulary for animals and habitats by using dictionary skills to find and understand new words. Pupils apply their language knowledge to create simple sentences and describe food chains.

Autumn 1	Portraits – describing in French	Autumn 2	Clothes – getting dressed in French
	Describing people in French by learning vocabulary for physical appearance and personality. Pupils create simple sentences and apply their understanding of adjective agreement to match the gender of the noun.		Learning vocabulary for clothing and using the correct forms of the indefinite article. Pupils describe outfits in French and begin to express and justify simple opinions about what people are wearing.
Spring 1	French numbers, calendars and birthdays	Spring 2	French weather and the water cycle
	Learning the numbers 1–31, days of the week, months of the year, dates and seasons through songs, games and surveys. Pupils apply their knowledge by researching and discussing the dates of French festivals.		Learning vocabulary for weather, compass points and temperature in French. Pupils count in multiples of ten from 10 to 100 and combine their language and number knowledge to describe weather conditions and temperatures.
Summer 1	French food – Miam, miam !	Summer 2	French and the Eurovision Song Contest
	Learning French vocabulary for food, prices and shopping. Pupils revise numbers to 100 in the context of money, develop their language detective skills and build confidence in practical conversations about buying food.		Creating and performing songs in French by revising vocabulary from Years 3 and 4. Pupils learn additional musical vocabulary, expand their knowledge of the French names for European countries and apply their language skills to write original lyrics.

Autumn 1	French monster pets	Autumn 2	Space exploration - in French
	Consolidating French grammar by revising noun gender, articles, adjective agreement and sentence structure. Pupils apply their knowledge by selecting the correct articles, ensuring adjectives agree with nouns and placing adjectives in the correct position within sentences.		Developing descriptive language in French by using figurative language, adjectives and prepositions. Pupils build more detailed sentences and learn how to make simple comparisons using adjectives.
Spring 1	Shopping in France	Spring 2	French-speaking world
	Learning how to construct larger numbers and use a wider range of food-related vocabulary. Pupils build on their understanding of sentence structure, questions and key phrases.		Learning about French-speaking countries while developing language for directions, climate and geography. Pupils give and follow directions, describe weather and climate, and use comparative language to make comparisons between places.
Summer 1	Verbs in a French week	Summer 2	Meet my French family
	Further developing knowledge of French grammar by identifying infinitive verbs and subject pronouns. Pupils learn how verbs can be grouped, recognise the difference between regular and irregular verbs and apply this knowledge in simple sentences.		Learning vocabulary for family members and relationships while using the possessive adjective 'my' and language to express likes and dislikes. Pupils develop their writing skills using and reorganising familiar words and phrases to compose a short written text.

Year 6			
	French sport and the Olympics		French football champions
Autumn 1	Developing French grammar and speaking skills by learning to conjugate the verb aller (to go) and use the correct prepositions. Pupils learn sports vocabulary and express preferences using the infinitive form of verbs.	Autumn 2	Developing language-learning strategies while building French reading, speaking and listening skills. Pupils respond to questions about footballers and use their growing vocabulary and grammatical knowledge to understand and communicate information.
	In my French house		Planning a French holiday
Spring 1	Describing homes in French by learning vocabulary for different rooms and the people who live there. Pupils develop their understanding of prepositions to explain where items are located within a bedroom and create simple descriptions of a house.	Spring 2	Using present and near-future tenses to talk about holidays and travel. Pupils learn vocabulary related to packing a suitcase and planning a journey, applying their language skills to discuss future plans and activities.

Summer 1	Developing French communication skills by learning vocabulary for transport, directions and prepositional phrases. Pupils practise expressing opinions and apply their language knowledge to talk about a trip to France.	Summer 2	[Revision]
