### Remembrance poppy

On Remembrance Day, people wear red poppies. The poppy is a symbol of remembering. Some people lay poppy wreaths during special services at war memorials and churches.



### poppy

A plant with a flower, usually red in colour.



### Remembrance Day

At 11 o'clock on Remembrance Day, people stop what they are doing and stay quiet for two minutes. They think about people who have fought and died in wars. This is called a two-minute silence.
